

Library

The mission of the Foreign Trade Library (FTL) is to assist IIFT in its endeavor to achieve recognition as an internationally top-ranked, research-driven management institute. The Library is designed to meet the academic and research needs of students and faculty members. As a comprehensive knowledge hub, the Library holds a rich collection of resources, including 1,09,807 printed books and bound volumes, over 70 journals, magazines, and newspapers, access to thousands of journals through ONOS, and more than 47 online databases. It is also equipped with multiple Bloomberg terminals for use by students for academic and research purposes.

Availability of Resources

- 1. A collection of the latest books by eminent authors on Trade, Economics, Management, WTO-related issues, Intellectual Property Rights, Mergers & Acquisitions, Trade Finance, e-Business, Global Business Strategies, International Business Law, Information Technology, and more.
- 2. A collection of journals, research reports, company reports, international trade statistics, CD-ROMs, video cassettes, etc.
- 3. Access to online journals from prominent publishers such as ScienceDirect (Elsevier), Taylor & Francis, Springer, Wiley Online Library, Oxford University Press, Cambridge University Press, and others.
- 4. Access to databases such as CMIE, CEIC, EMIS, Euromonitor, Statista, S&P Global Trade Atlas, and many more.

Computer Centre

IIFT's Computer Centre combines dual 1 GBps leased lines with campus-wide high-speed Wi-Fi and a dedicated 40-seat Data Analytics Lab to guarantee 99 percent uptime, seamless access to SPSS, Hadoop, SAS and CMIE databases, and uninterrupted streaming of live lectures. Advanced video and web-conferencing link all the campuses and power real-time online sessions on the institute's MOOC platform, while a secure VPN ensures remote e-library access. All academic activities—from attendance and courseware to quizzes, assignments and research submissions—are centrally managed through the in-house Campus360 platform, delivering a fully integrated, lag-free learning experience 24×7.

Academic Rules

• Punctuality & attendance are of paramount importance.

- In the MBA IB and BA (Full-time) programs, students are required to maintain a minimum of 80% attendance in all courses.
- Attendance waivers are granted only in cases of medical emergencies or other urgent situations.
- At IIFT, the evaluation of all courses follows a 50/50 principle: 50% of the assessment is based on internal evaluations, such as quizzes, assignments, projects, and case discussions, while the remaining 50% is assessed through the end-term examination
- It is extremely important that students complete all the internal components of course before taking the end term exam.
