OFFICE ORDER

The Competent Authority has approved the following amendments in the "Policy on Incentives for Research Publications at IIFT" circulated vide Office Order No.Admn.10(33)/98 dated 8th January, 2018.

- With effect from 1st January, 2021, the condition that IIFT author must be the first/corresponding author is removed and all other conditions will remain the same i.e. incentives (proportional to number of authors) may be made to all IIFT faculty only depending on the category of Journals subject to IIFT affiliation being mentioned in the papers against the author who is claiming the amount.
- ii. Claim date by a faculty for research incentive will be considered as final and latest ABDC journal listing available at that time will be considered. Date of sanction/availability of ABDC or equivalent journal list on the website will be considered final and the same will be considered while processing any claim by the faculty.

Illustration: In case a faculty claims based on acceptance mail (As per current incentive policy, he/she needs to give an undertaking) and let's say the journal is ABDC "C" category listed, when the paper appears as published, the journal is also re-ranked by ABDC and placed now in "B" category. In such a case, no new claim for sanction of additional amount will be entertained as he/she has already claimed the amount based on the acceptance mail.

- iii. A faculty is eligible to claim for the incentive amount for a research publication only either in the year it is accepted or when it is published. The faculty must claim within 6 months from the publication/acceptance date. Late submission of claim by the faculty, will be subject to approval of Director. Any such applicant must seek approval from the Director stating the reasons for late submission of the claim after obtaining approval from IQAC.
- As a part of regular review of the research incentives towards publication in iv. quality journals, the UGC and Scopus listed journals will be discontinued for processing of payments w.e.f. 1.1.2021. However, Institute would continue to process payments for ABDC "C" listed journals @INR 50,000 (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) per paper as per Policy on Incentives for Research Publications.

- v. In case the faculty submits his/her claim based on acceptance letter, he/she must submit the same along with declaration that:
 - (a) He/she is one or sole author of the paper and the paper has IIFT affiliation;
 - b) He/she will submit the published paper as it is available on the website which should be within one year from claim date.

In case of papers not published even after one year from the date of claim, no further claims towards research incentives of the faculty will be processed till he/she submits the published paper/first page of the website. In case of delay in submission of Publication, he/she also needs to apply immediately to IQAC stating the reasons (with complete correspondence), else financial recovery process will be initiated for the amount claimed by the faculty.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
