QUERIES FROM BIDDERS ON ABOVE TENDER AND IT'S CLARIFICATIONS

Further to Tender Ref No.: 87/06/2023-24_CTIL, dated: 13 September 2023, with CPP Tender ID No: 2023_IIFT_727049_1 published by Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, New Delhi. Since the Institute has been receiving several queries, the Corrigendum is hereby issued as follows:

S. No.	Query / Clarification Sought	Clarifications
1.	Clause 2 Objective of the Tender	The bidder can propose any scenario building and modelling mechanism which they believe would be helpful for the Study.
2.	Clause No. 3 (i) Gathering of primary and secondary data on proprietary related to GHG emissions in iron, steel, Aluminium, electricity, and allied sectors.	The Study should focus on unilateral measures related to GHG emissions, measures. While emphasis should be on the sectors mentioned in the tender clause, the Study should be in line with India's major exports to jurisdictions adopting or implementing measures related to GHG measures.
3.	Clause No. 3 (ii) Consultations with MSMEs/SMEs/experts/training centers and any other relevant stakeholders in GHG emissions field.	If the primary and secondary data as per paragraph 3(i) has been obtained, the bidder need not consult the relevant stakeholders.
4.	Clause No. 3 (v) Analysis of customs compliance implications for Indian exporters. Clause No. 3 (vi) Highlighting areas in customs compliance which may require adjustments to comply with CBAM.	The Study should analyse overall implications for Indian exporters regarding general customs and regulatory compliance in importing jurisdictions.

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5.	Annexure – 1 at page 10 Draft TOR	The bidders are required to prepare a ToR which should highlight the scope of work & chapterization of Study.
6.	Clause No. 8 (a) Technical Evaluation Annexure – 1 at page 10 Team composition	The evaluation will be done on various criteria which include, among others, number of years of relevant experience, previous studies conducted on similar issues/subjects, the quality of work done in past years etc.
7.	Clause 13 (a) Earnest Money Deposit	EMD is refundable
8.	Clause No. 22 Near-relationship certificate	Requirement under paragraph 22 of the tender document is mandatory as part of the bidding process.
