Number of Positions: 01

Consolidated Fee: The candidate will be paid a consolidated salary of Rs.75, 000/- per month (including telephone expenses). The candidate with the best talent may be offered upto Rs. 1,00,000/-

Duration: The appointment will be purely on a contract basis for one year. The tenure can be extended depending on the performance of the candidate and the requirements of the Institute renewable yearly.

Age limit: Minimum 30 years and maximum 50 years as on the last date of receipt of the application.

Key Responsibilities:

- To provide mental health/ psychological counselling services to students and other stakeholders.
- Carry out psychological testing
- Must be available to students' online/on phone, beyond the office hours, in cases of emergency.
- Information collected from any of the stakeholders during the process must be kept confidential. Data collection for personal research should be avoided by all means.
- Submission of weekly report to Head of the division regarding well-being of students with information on critical cases.
- Work with student communities, staff and their dependents to improve psychological wellness and to address mental health issues.

Essential Qualification:

- M.Phil/ M.A. in Clinical Psychology from a recognised University/Institute.
- He/She should have a valid current registration with the Rehabilitation Council of India as a Clinical Psychologist.
- Candidates with experience in providing counselling services at Higher Educational Institutions in the past would be preferred.
- Must be able to communicate in Hindi and English.

Work Experience:

Minimum 05 years of experience as counselor.

meetings or sessions.
